

Safety Plan for Participating in Scenarios

- Minimum of 1 to Maximum of 50 person gathered
- PPE recommended (masks, gloves)
- Non- contact temperature taken of each participant and Trainer

Trainer takes temperature of every participant prior to entering the training location. *Any person (to include the Trainer) will be denied entry with a temperature at or above 99.5 degrees (let person rest five (5) minutes if temperature is at or above 99.5 degrees and retest to confirm). NOTE: The reason for 99.5 is because contactless forehead thermometers tend to have ± 1 -degree margin of error, so 99.5 really means 100.5 which aligns with your original suggestion.*

Hand sanitizer will be made available for everyone is use and will be used upon entering training location and after every scenario. Masks (face coverings) and rubber gloves will be mandated and made available for all participants and Trainers. A short demonstration on how to wear and take off gloves will be provided by the Trainer. *Any person refusing to wear the required PPE will be asked to exit the training location.*

All equipment used in a scenario will be disinfected after each use to include: NERF gun, NERF balls, Air horn, Glasses (at beginning and end of training), gloves.

To secure a weapon free training area, the Trainer will perform a pat down search for weapons on same sex participants. The Trainer will conduct these searches while wearing a face mask and new pair of gloves. For opposite sex participants and participants not submitting to a weapon check from the Trainer, each participant will perform a “self-check” in front of the assigned Trainer. This will include each participant pulling out their front pockets completely out and running their hand over the outside of their pants and shirt. *Any person refusing to submit to a Trainer conducted weapon search will be asked to exit the training location.*

When running scenarios: Brief and debrief in large area to allow for 6 feet of distance between participants, place each person into scenario with distancing in mind, contact should be minimized and only occur in pat down, incidental during evacuation and briefly in SWARM. (as attendees feel comfortable performing.)
